Rosa Daniels McKissic Scholarship

Essay Prompt:

Dwight McKissic Scholarship

Essay Prompt:

Vera McKissic Scholarship

Essay Prompt:

As a new voter, share what qualities you feel make a good political candidate and why. Also, should Christians vote even if they do not believe there is a fully qualified candidate...why or why not?

500 word minimum

General Youth Scholarships
